**Description of the Project** Galaxy holds one of three existing casino licenses in Macao, the world's biggest gambling hub after Las Vegas and the only place in China where casinos are legal.



A unique "Mythical Themed" building exterior. The Resort pretend to be a "must tour" for all visitors to Macao. The theme is designed by Gary Goddard Entertainment, who has designed a number of major themed attractions around the globe including "The Forum Shops at Caesars Palace". The interior decoration was done by well-known resort and entertainment design house - Hirsch Bedner Associates, whom had designed a number of major hotels and resorts throughout the world. Incorporated into the Resort is the largest roof top garden in Macao, giving Galaxy's facility a truly Resort flavor and allowing visitors to enjoy a tropical paradise experience.

The Resort offer what is believed to be the widest selection of Asian and Chinese food facilities in Macao. All of this is supported by an extensive Chinese entertainment program that delights all visitors to Macao. It is estimated that approximately 95% of all visitors to Macao are ethnic Chinese.

Galaxy's expanded and accelerated development plans, pretended to be a additional up-graded facilities at Cotai was strongly supported by the significant infrastructure works presently being undertaken by the Macao Government. These infrastructure works include the expansion in the capacity of the Gongbei Gate, the expansion and re-opening of the Lotus Bridge Immigration Centre (next door to Galaxy Cotai) and the rapid development of the second Ferry Terminal, which is five minutes from Galaxy Cotai.
